## **Housing Committee 2007 Report**

Five affordable housing units have become available in two housing developments for homeless families:

- ④ Jacobsville Apartments opened Phase II which includes 2 set-aside units
- ④ Dale Haven Estates completed renovations and began leasing which includes 3 set-aside units

More will come available in 2008:

- ④ Memorial Development Community Development Corporation was awarded funding for 34 units of affordable housing which includes 2 set-aside units for homeless families. Construction has already begun.

The HUD 2007 Continuum of Care grant application was submitted in June with a funding request for rental assistance for 20 units for singles and 20 scattered site units for families with disabilities. Funding awards are still pending.

Partners in Housing Development Corporation, in Indianapolis, is partnering with Southwestern Indiana Mental Health Center and Aurora to develop 60 units of permanent supportive housing for singles. The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2008.

The State of Indiana moved forward with legislation designating a regular funding source for the Affordable Housing and Community Development Fund which will help fund affordable and permanent supportive housing projects across the state. The Housing Committee will be interested in completing funding requests as they are made available.

The City of Evansville is reviewing available sources for funding and program guidelines for the local Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

Interest from four different agencies to sponsor an additional 63 units of housing has been submitted for funding consideration in the 2008 HUD Continuum of Care grant.

We mourn the loss of Gregg LaMar, former chair of the committee.

The Housing Committee looks forward to the opportunities of 2008.
